Greetings from Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited!

We wish to inform you that vide their Order dated 30<sup>st</sup> March 2020 in Case No. 325 of 2019, Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission has announced revised electricity tariffs applicable to consumers of Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited (AEML). The new tariff is effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020. The detailed Tariff Schedule is available on the following URL on our website: <https://bit.ly/2R6yXEG>

In addition to the changes in tariff rates, the following changes in categorization and other tariff and billing related terms and conditions brought about by the new Order are provided below:

1. In view of the corona virus pandemic, **moratorium has been provided on payment of fixed charges** of the electricity bill by consumers under Industrial and Commercial category for next three billing cycles beginning from the lockdown date of 25/3/2020
2. Regulatory asset charges (RAC) **stopped.**
3. Consumers having IT and ITES units are no longer required to submit certification under GoM's IT & ITES policy to avail Industrial category tariff.
4. Rs. 10/- discount per month for consumers opting for E-Bill. No hard copy to be generated for these consumers.
5. Some of the existing consumer categories have been discontinued and consumers in these categories at present will be merged with other categories as provided below:

LT V – Advertisement & Hoardings	LT II – Commercial
LT VI – Street Light	LT IX (B) – Public Services (Others)
LT VII (a) – Temporary Supply (Religious)	LT I (B) – Residential Temporary supply consumers shall pay 1.5 times the Fixed Charges applicable for the category
LT VII (b) – Temporary Supply (Others)	LT II – Commercial Temporary supply consumers shall pay 1.5 times the Fixed Charges and 1.25 times the Energy Charge applicable for the category.
LT VIII – Crematorium and Burial Grounds	LT I (B) – Residential

6. Following activities are now reclassified under different categories as below:
- Independent R&D units are now categorized under Industrial category (presently categorized in Commercial category)
  - Telecommunication towers categorized under Industrial category (presently categorized in Commercial category)
  - Hostels categorized under LT - Public Service (Others) category (presently categorized in LT – residential category)
  - Public Sanitary Conveniences categorized under LT - Public Service (Govt. Educational Institutions and Hospitals) category (presently categorized in LT – Street Light category)
7. Cash payment of electricity bills is restricted to Rs. 5,000/- per customer per month.
8. PF Incentive / Penalty is now applicable only for LT II: Non-Residential/Commercial [LT II (B), LT II (C)] (for Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load **above 20 kW**), LT III (B): Industry above 20 kW, LT IV: Public Service [LT IV (A) and LT IV (B)], and LT VI – Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations having contract demand/sanctioned load **above 20 kW**.

The summary of rates is given below.

We are arranging to migrate identified cases to their respective new categories. However, you are requested to review your current tariff category as per the applicability of the tariffs mentioned in the new tariff schedule and approach AEML on [helpdesk.mumbaielectricity@adani.com](mailto:helpdesk.mumbaielectricity@adani.com) for recategorization if required or for any other query.
