INFLATED BILLS: ADANI OFFERS 3 EMIS FOR POWER BILL PAYMENT

MUMBAI:Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited (AEML) consumers can now pay their bills in three interest-free instalments, the company said in a press statement released on Thursday. The facility can be availed of by consumers who pay their EMIs before due date, AEML said.

As per directives issued by the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC), consumers who have received electricity bills more than double the average between March and May, have to be given the option of paying their bills in three EMIs.
