Adani Electricity and government institutions rise up to the challenge of COVID-19

- Supply released to 2957 flats and 9 hospitals with 500 bed capacity identified for quarantine purpose
- Additional 455 flats electrification in progress for quarantine purpose
- Supply released within 24 hours to a 30,000 sq. feet camp at Versova ground built by Maharashtra Home Guards with a capacity to accommodate 500 people

Mumbai, 16th April, 2020: In Mumbai, there are over 1936 cases of COVID-19 so far. The State Government, MCGM, District Collector along with other statutory authorities are working rigorously to combat COVID-19 pandemic. The new guidelines issued by the Union Ministry of Health to prioritize early detection and quarantine are one of the key methods to reduce the spread of COVID-19. As a part of this approach, the creation of large-scale quarantine facilities has become a necessity. There are several vacant buildings, and un-inhabited complexes which have been converted to quarantine facilities. Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited with solid government support have been installing and supplying electricity on an emergency basis in these quarantine areas as most of them lack access to power.

Adani Electricity has been providing uninterrupted electricity supply on priority, to all the affected locations in the western and eastern areas including hospitals that fall under their purviews such as a Maternity Care Centre in Shivaji Nagar, an MCGM hospital in Andheri and a few more residential areas that are under quarantine. In cooperation with MCGM, District Collector, Civil Defense Directorate and SRA authorities, AEML has provided electricity connections in various quarantine centers across the city, which lacked electricity access.

Speaking about the electricity supply identified by various government authorities for quarantine purpose, AEML spokesperson said, "Our on-ground team so far has released supply to 2957 flats spread across our Distribution area. We are also in process of releasing supply to additional 455 flats. Apart from flats, we have released supply to 9 hospitals with 500 bed capacity and a 30,000 sq feet tent at Versova ground built Maharashtra Home Guards which can accommodate 500 people."

In this pandemic situation, the essential employees of Adani Electricity who have been working relentlessly are the unsung heroes and have undertaken their tasks in a selfless manner. The initiative is to enable people to live safely and get access to uninterrupted electricity which is the basic need during the lockdown period. AEML has been actively working to ensure the safety and well-being of its employees during the process of providing safe and reliable power supply by providing them transportation service to
