Mumbai: November 01, 2021: Adani Electricity has already taken steps to reduce Mumbai's carbon footprint. This will offset upto ~16% of Mumbai's total GHG emissions and make Mumbai one of the World's first Metropolis to be powered by such a significant share of Renewable Energy.

The Company has linked these targets with financial penalty for non-achievement under its recent issuance of US Dollar denominated Bond to international investors, demonstrating commitment.

A Green Tariff has been rolled out wherein consumers can opt for supply from Renewable Energy sources. Adani is also offering a subsidy of upto 40% to promote solar rooftop installations. More than 30,000 consumers have opted for these initiatives displacing equivalent of more than 26,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide annually, equivalent to planting ~850,000 trees. Moreover, Adani Electricity is planting one sapling on behalf of every consumer who opts for paperless bills.

Additionally, Adani Electricity is forming strategic partnerships to promote Electric Mobility in Mumbai. From hosting a First of its kind Electric Vehicle Rally across the Green Lungs of Mumbai to powering charging infrastructure and battery swapping
