## Outsourcing of Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Padlock with Chain

### A. Proposed Scope of Work:

Scope of work consists of

#### 1. Arrangement of adequate manpower and preparation for installation of Padlock

Under this activity, it is expected from vendor to supply adequate manpower as per the requirement of AEML in time and comply all safety, quality norms of AEML and other statutory bodies (viz. MCGM, MERC, Traffic etc.)

##### Activities involved:

- a) Provision of adequate qualified manpower conforming eligibility to work on electrical network as per CEA regulations. along with vehicle, smart phone, necessary tools & PPEs,
- b) Receiving of details of LT Pillars from AEML engineer.
- c) Transportation of padlocks and accessories from respective AEML Zone / Division store to site as directed by AEML engineer.
- d) Visiting site and verify the LT Pillar details and confirming the LT pillar body does not any leakage current. view of safety.
- e) Scrapping of LT Pillar surface before welding wherever required.
- f) Use of portable DG sets and welding machines for welding purpose.
- g) Scrapping of welded portion of pillar door.
- h) Touch painting post welding of padlock.
- i) Use of all necessary PPEs (viz. safety gloves, safety shoes, welding goggles, fluorescent jackets etc.) confirming relevant IS.

#### 2. Installation of Padlocks HT/LT cable jointing work

Under this activity, it is expected from vendor to timely complete committed quantity of works as per AEML requirements and following quality & safety norms of AEML for cable jointing works.

##### Activities involved:

- a) Adherence to SoP of work of AEML for safety & quality practices at site.
- b) Checking and confirming the LT pillar GIS number before commencing the work.

- c) Adherence to the instructions of AEML engineer In-charge from time to time to carry out work.

### 3. Post Installation compliances

Under this activity, it is expected from vendor to carry out activities post padlock installation per AEML set process & reporting completion of activity in prescribed format.

#### Activities involved:

- a) Protecting of welded portion using touchup paint as per AEML guidelines.
- b) Segregation of solid, metal & hazardous waste at site & loading it in "R-Y-B" crates in vehicle as per IMS Policy of AEML.
- c) Adherence to all safety standards of AEML.
- d) Submitting back duly filled job card issued to him, after completion of job.
- e) Submission of GIS pillar no wise installation report in soft form as per AEML format.
- f) Updating the reports including work completion, material reconciliation to unit AEML engineer, on daily basis in prescribed format.
- g) Ensuring the pillar door, if opened / found open, is closed & locked properly.
- h) Submitting bills to respective unit on Monthly basis which will be approved by concerned zone / division in charge.

## B. PLPBC (Productivity Linked Performance Based Contract) Terms

### 1. Timeline

- a) Vendor team shall report to zone office daily and commence the work within 1 hr. (excluding heavy Rains / Continuous Water Logging / Any other Public Hindrances where there is no possibility to carry out this activity at site)
- b) Vendor shall provide guarantee of at least 5 years for padlocks supplied and of his workmanship against poor quality of welding made by him.  
However, in case of malfunctioning of padlocks or failure of any welding installation made by him; due to deficiency in skills or deviation in process, vendors must replace / repair the same at his own cost (cost inclusive of Material / Manpower) and provide detailed investigation report & RCA for the same.

- c) Vendor will ensure execution of committed quantity within defined time as follows, post complete delivery of materials at AEML stores:

## 2. Code of conduct

- Vendor shall provide to his crew, an identity card of his company and the same shall be displayed by crew member while on duty.
- Crew member shall be properly dressed and presentable while on duty and his behavior & conduct shall not adversely impact the brand image of AEML.
- Crew member shall not leave his duty and continue to work till his work is over. In any case crew member shall not leave the site unattended. Under circumstances beyond control, crew member shall take necessary permission from AEML Engineer.

## C. Pay-out / Penalty / Incentive Formula based on K- factor:

Pay-out will be based on adherence of PLPBC terms and condition for “Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Padlock with Chain” of timeline and code of conduct, are as below.

- Based on performance of timeline, vendor will be eligible for additional incentive / deduction as below.

- b) Based on performance of code & conduct, vendor will be eligible for additional incentive / deduction as below.

S No	B. Conduct Compliance Score	K Factor	Incentive / Penalty (B)
1	Compliance Score = 100	0.05	Incentive / Penalty = Monthly Bill * K Factor
2	Compliance Score > 90	0.00	
3	Compliance Score > 75 & < 90	-0.05	
4	Compliance Score > 50 & < 75	-0.15	
5	Compliance Score < 50	-0.50	

- c) **Total Payout = Payout (A) + Payout (B)**
- d) Penalty at actual shall be imposed if any damage to other cable or other utility's asset or violating norms of statutory bodies during work.
- e) Penalty of Rs 5000/- shall be imposed if crew person is involved in any unlawful activity and will be solely at cost and consequence of vendor. Vendor shall immediately terminate the person responsible and shall provide immediate replacement as per AEML requirement.
- f) Any loss to human, animal & property due to work carried out by vendor personnel will be solely at cost and consequence of vendor.
- g) AEML reserves the right to terminate the contract at any point in case of repeated Non-Performance.
